



A.R. and Marylouise Tandy Floral Terraces Seasonal Descriptions

Spring

The Tandy Floral Terraces in the spring is a sight to behold with around 150,000 bulbs blooming throughout the season, including tulips, daffodils, grape hyacinth, crocus, squill, camas lilies, bluebells, allium, and many others. From the bottom of the Floral Terraces, you will be surrounded by an English cottage garden of daffodils, grape hyacinth, and allium, as well as some of the early perennials like catmint and irises. The color scheme is purple, blue, and white, with some yellow daffodils also mixed in. From the top of the garden you will be surrounded by walls of our beautiful Colorado blue spruce trees, and also have one of the best views of the massive seasonal tulip display, which changes from year to year.

Summer

The choreography of our plantings changes almost weekly throughout the summer, showing off our spectacular collection of thousands of plants including lilies, roses, cannas, hummingbird mint, and hundreds more. The bottom of the Floral Terraces is surrounded by an impressive cottage garden display of traditional purple, pink, and white flowering perennials and bulbs, as well as some pale yellow lilies. The top of the garden has a great view of our summer annual display, and is surrounded by hundreds of lilies, butterfly bushes, and blue spruce trees. Early-mid June is typically when most of the lilies are in full bloom.

Autumn

Fall in the Floral Terraces allows you to experience the biggest diversity of flowering plants, showcasing most of our summer plants that are still blooming, but also a new palate of fall plants such as chrysanthemums, ginger lilies, doll's daisy, and sunflowers. The bottom of the garden is home to the beautiful doll's daisy which looks like clouds of white throughout the garden, as well as the more tropical looking cannas and extremely fragrant ginger lilies. The top of the Floral Terraces offers a spectacular overall view of the garden, while being surrounded by our room of blue spruce trees and magenta blooming crape myrtles.

Winter

While not much is flowering during winter in the Floral Terraces, the winter season offers a chance to experience our collection evergreen plants, many different colors of berries growing from shrubs, and a variety of textures from the seedheads of our plants. You will find hedges of many evergreens throughout the garden, including boxwoods, yaupon hollies, foster hollies, arborvitae, nandinas, yews, and spruce trees. The bottom of the Floral Terraces offers hundreds of evergreen hollies boxwoods, and nandinas, as well as spectacular views of the 7 acre pond. The top of the garden offers even more stunning views of our TBG pond and downtown Tulsa, while being surrounded by our room of Colorado blue spruce trees.
